



FOR ACADEMIC, CHARACTER AND LEADERSHIP AWARDS

Lighthouse Christian School desires to recognise and honour the academic, character and leadership attributes of its student body. The Annual Awards Ceremony, held at the conclusion of the school year, has traditionally provided a public forum for this to occur.

In addition to the criteria outlined for each specific award, all recipients must fulfil the following two school expectations, these being:

- Students maintain the three school rules: Respect for God, Respect for Others and Respect for Self;
- Students maintain a school attendance rate for the year of at least 90% (excludes absence due to significant medical condition / significant family trauma).

Further, award recipients will have been enrolled at Lighthouse Christian School for a *minimum* of One Semester.

The purpose of this document is to list the awards presented at the school's Annual Awards evening, and to outline the criteria for selecting recipients.

ANNUAL AWARDS - PRIMARY DEPARTMENT (P-Y6)

Academic Awards:

- Subject Awards (certificate):
 - » Awarded to the highest achieving student in each Key Learning Area;
 - » Awarded for each year level (P-6).
- Overall Academic Achiever (trophy):
 - » Awarded to the highest achieving student across English, Maths and Science;
 - » Awarded for each year level (P-6);
 - » Recipients will have attained no less than a "C" in ALL Key Learning Areas.

Character and Leadership Awards:

- Christian Character Awards (monetary gift):
 - » Awarded to a student who is able to demonstrate the mission of Lighthouse Baptist Church; that is, to LOVE Jesus; BECOME like Jesus; and to COMMUNICATE Jesus;
 - » Recipients will have demonstrated our school verse: 1 Timothy 4:12 "Let no man despise thy youth, but be thou an example of the believers, in WORK, in CONVERSATION, in CHARITY, in SPIRIT, in FAITH, in PURITY;
 - » Student must have completed all scripture memorisation activities throughout the year;
 - » Awarded for each year level (P-6).
- Scripture Memorisation Awards (trophy):
 - » Awarded to students who have demonstrated their memorisation of weekly scripture verses;
 - » NB: The number of scripture verses to be memorised for awardees will be at the discretion of the School Principal.

- The Primary Sports person of the year trophy is awarded to a person in Yr 4-6 who:
 - » Has been involved in a majority of the school sports teams available
 - » Has shown a high level of skill, not only in developing their own personal ability but in developing team members.
 - » Has demonstrated the school value of respect for others through teamwork during training and games, the way they speak to their team mates and members of opposing teams
 - » Has demonstrated the school value of respect for self by being prepared for each training session and game with their uniform and other necessary equipment, an 80% attendance rate for the games and also the training.
 - » Has demonstrated a respect for God through their attitude toward scripture memorisation, chapel and bible classes
 - » Has demonstrated a positive attitude towards all school work and school staff.



ANNUAL AWARDS - JUNIOR SECONDARY DEPARTMENT (Y7 - Y10)

Academic Awards:

- Subject Awards (certificate):
 - » Awarded to the highest achieving student in each Key Learning Area;
 - » Awarded for each year level (Y7-Y10).
- Overall Academic Achiever (trophy):
 - » Awarded to the highest achieving student across ALL Key Learning Areas (moderated result). All subjects are of equal weighting;
 - » Awarded for each year level (Y7-Y10);
 - » Recipients will have attained no less than a "C" in ALL Key Learning Areas.

Character and Leadership Awards:

- Christian Character Awards (monetary gift):
 - » Awarded to a student who is able to demonstrate the mission of Lighthouse Baptist Church, that is, to LOVE Jesus; BECOME like Jesus; and to COMMUNICATE Jesus;
 - » Recipients will have demonstrated our school verse: 1 Timothy 4:12 "Let no man despise thy youth, but be thou an example of the believers, in WORK, in CONVERSATION, in CHARITY, in SPIRIT, in FAITH, in PURITY;

 - » Student will demonstrate the mission of Lighthouse Baptist Church, that is, to LOVE Jesus; BECOME like Jesus; and to COMMUNICATE Jesus;
 - » Student will consistently demonstrate some or all of the following:
 - Allegiance to God;
 - Servant Leadership;
 - Teamwork and Problem Solving Skills;
 - Biblical Values;
 - Communication Skills.

 - » Awarded to two students (one in Y10, one in Y12) who demonstrate leadership and teamwork within both the school and the broader local community;
 - » Selected by the School Principal, the students will demonstrate the following traits:
 - Determination;
 - Mateship;
 - Teamwork;
 - Tenacity;
 - Compassion;
 - Leadership.
- James Cook University Year 10 Academic Encouragement Awards (Top 2 Y10 Academic Achievers) (certificate / monetary):
 - » Exhibits the greatest academic achievement or progress in their studies;
 - » Exemplifies a commitment to building the economic and social fabric of their community especially in Regional Australia;
 - » Demonstrates resilience and perseverance in their studies or extracurricular accomplishments.

Health and Physical Education Awards:

- Overall School Sports Champion Awards (certificate / trophy):
 - » Awarded to two students (one male, one female) who achieved the best aggregate score in 2 different activities (The Cooper Run, The Beep Test and Circuit Training) over Years 7-10;

- *The Junior Secondary Sportsperson of the year trophy is awarded to a person in Yr 7-10 who:*
 - » *Has been involved in a majority of the school sports teams available*
 - » *Has shown a high level of skill, not only in developing their own personal ability but in developing team members.*
 - » *Has demonstrated the school value of respect for others through teamwork during training and games, the way they speak to their team mates and members of opposing teams*
 - » *Has demonstrated the school value of respect for self by being prepared for each training session and game with their uniform and other necessary equipment, an 80% attendance rate for the games and also the training.*

ANNUAL AWARDS - SENIOR SECONDARY DEPARTMENT (Y11 - Y12)

Academic Awards:

- Subject Awards (certificate):
 - » Awarded to the highest achieving student in each Subject;
 - » Awarded for each year level (Y11-Y12).
- CQUniversity Year 11 Overall Academic Achiever (trophy):
 - » Awarded to the highest achieving Year 11 student across five OP subjects, plus sixth OP subject or equivalent (eg. SUN – Start University Now);
 - » Recipient will have attained no less than a “Sound Achievement” in ALL subjects studied.
- Dux of School - Year 12 Overall Academic Achiever (trophy):
 - » Awarded to the highest achieving Year 12 student across five general subjects or equivalent (eg. SUN – Start University Now);
 - » Recipient must be ATAR eligible;
 - » Recipient will have attained no less than a “Sound Achievement” in ALL subjects studied.
- Principal’s Award – Top Four Year 12 Overall Academic Achievers (trophy/certificate):
 - » Awarded to the four highest achieving, ATAR eligible Year 12 Students, across five general subjects.
 - *NOTE: Dux of School have met the criteria for dux and will be selected from these four students.*
 - » Recipients will have attained no less than a “Sound Achievement” in ALL subjects studied.

Character and Leadership Awards:

- Christian Character Awards (monetary gift):
 - » Awarded to a student (Y11, Y12) who is able to demonstrate the mission of Lighthouse Baptist Church, that is, to LOVE Jesus; BECOME like Jesus; and to COMMUNICATE Jesus;
